What we do: WCTS follows the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®) as the Standard for Project Management. Our certified Project Managers tailor standardized processes for each project. Our adaptive approach ensures portfolios, programs, and projects are Value-driven in that they aim for value rather than predictable results.

WCTS uses an Integrated Program Management Office (PMO) approach to ensure basic Project Management Institute (PMI) standards are adhered to. We establish PMO functions such as Finance, Human Resources, Contracts, Logistics, Security, Risk Management, and Quality Assurance. We staff the PMO with Subject Matter Experts (SME) and other professionals with certifications in Project Management, Knowledge Management, and Lean Six Sigma. In lieu of an oversight function, the PMO serves as an enabler to our PMs and their teams.

How we do it: We assist organizations to select projects that will help them reach their strategic goals. We refer to the 12 principles and 8 performance domains of project management to guide project teams.

Rather than solely focusing on deliverables, we use various Project Management techniques and hybrid approach to help our customers reach their objectives in which value can be measured.



- ✓ Predictive: This approach is used when the scope and requirements are easy to define and well understood. Our experience in similar projects can save resources.
- ✓ Adaptive (Agile): Used when requirements are complex or expected to evolve. An iterative approach seeks stakeholder acceptance before advancing to the next phase, allowing us to reduce risk and resource waste.

We designed an Earned Value “LIKE” approach to our management team’s analysis and variance reporting and mitigation decisions; it highlights an approach to organizing, planning, budgeting, accounting, analyzing, reporting, revising, and maintaining a complete operational picture of all on-going tasks. We develop program metrics that are simple and traceable to real data.

Where we’ve done it: For 5 years, the National Guard Bureau trusted WCTS to manage their portfolio of training transformation programs/projects; managed two NGB-level programs with 27 separate funded projects. In 2021, WCTS was awarded the SECAF Government Project of the year for supporting the Department of Homeland Security in managing performance of 12 Bombing Prevention Projects/Programs.
